Assisted Suicide Bill

Kenneth Stevenson, our MP, has written to about his position on the proposed legislation in relation to Assisted Dying. "This is a proposal that I do not support. ... I am not convinced that the position palliative care finds itself in Scotland, and indeed across the United Kingdom, is one that would allow individuals to make an informed choice.

Furthermore, I am not convinced that safeguards would be adequate to alleviate the many concerns people have rising from existing international examples.

... I am a firm believer in strong hospice and palliative care provision and ultimately for as long as funding constraints hold back the potential of such provision to improve end of life care, I cannot see Assisted Dying as a fair or just alternative."
